The St. John's Historic Cemetery and adjoining churchyard were created from a pasture of the old Ridgefield Plantation, owned by George Seth Guion and his wife Caroline Lucretia Winder, and were both established in 1843. The cemetery has served as a burial place for people of all faiths. Burial structures at St. John's reflect various architectural styles and materials. Styles range from simple ground-level tombs and grand monuments to a more recent ground crypt mausoleum.
