


Get Wild on the Bayou



Welcome to Lafourche Parish, affectionately nicknamed "<u>Louisiana's Cajun Bayou</u>." If you enjoy adventure and having a wild time on the bayou, this is the tour for you!

Start your day by booking a kayak or paddle board rental with <u>Geaux Paddle</u>. Located in Thibodaux and Raceland, Geaux Paddle is a self-service rental facility that offers you the chance to venture into Bayou Lafourche. Book online to reserve your time, and enjoy a wild time on the bayou where you might see an alligator or two.



Next, stop in at one of our <u>Cajun Bayou Food Trail</u> restaurants for lunch. Try something new and get your fix of soft-shell crab, shrimp pulled straight from the Gulf, catfish chips (Pictured), and more! Find local restaurants <u>HERE</u>.



After you've fueled up, it's time to see some alligators! Select from a choice of swamp and airboat tours in Lafourche Parish. Rip through the water on an airboat tour with <u>Airboat Tours by Arther Matherne</u>. Enjoy the stories of a true local Cajun legend while gliding on a pontoon boat at <u>Zam's Swamp Tours and Ecological Park</u> (Tour available in French). Or travel Bayou Des Allemands with <u>2 Da Swamp Tours</u> and see 100-yeard old Cypress trees and of course – friendly alligators (Tour available in French). (Photo Credit: Vesna Dies).
