

Begin your experience in Thibodaux on a relaxing Boat Tour on Bayou Lafourche. Board the boat at the *Jean Lafitte National Historic Park and Preserve Wetlands Acadian Cultural Center* and travel to the *E. D.White Historic Site*. The E. D.White Historic Site is an Antebellum Creole cottage that displays the area's plantation culture and the history of the late Governor E. D. White and U.S. Supreme Court Chief Justice E. D. White, II.

Discover the ambiance of Bayou Boeuf on one of *Torres Cajun Swamp Tours*. Enjoy the scenery and wildlife, watch the egrets and cranes, and feed alligators as Captain Roland Torres channels through the marshlands and swamps. While cruising on the Bayou, Captain Torres will tell you how he lived "off the land," in the areas' swamps, lakes, and bayous.

Explore Bayou Boeuf's hidden treasure, *Zam's Bayou Swamp Tours*. Captain Lloyd Loupe will give you a guided tour of wildlife, before taking you on a relaxing swamp tour on Bayou Boeuf. Walk through the farm, and view an array of animals and critters, and watch how Captain Loupe communicates with the alligators. If you are bold enough, play with the baby alligators and hold the pet snakes.

Grab some refreshments and gifts at **Zam's GatorBait II Gift Shop**. Choose from a selection of T-shirts with alligator heads, alligator necklaces, coon skin hats, back scratchers made from the feet of alligators, and wind chimes made from snails out of Bayou Boeuf.

For lunch, travel just minutes away from Zam's to *Trudy's Restaurant*. Enjoy some crab patties, Cajun style fried chicken, or a good "ole" fashioned burger. While dining, relax in the quaint atmosphere and view the pictures of hundreds of men and women from the area who served in the Civil War, World War I, and World War II.

After lunch, travel to Des Allemands to experience an adventurous airboat tour on *Airboat Tours by Arthur Matherne*. As the captain speeds through the marshes and swamps of the bayou, you will get a chance to see the beauty of the water plants, the graceful cypress trees, and visit with the alligators and other lifelong residents of the bayou.

Travel to Lockport and get up close and personal with nature on the *Lockport Elevated Wetlands Boardwalk*. Admire the beautiful scenic setting of the outdoors surrounding

Bayou Lafourche on this winding 440 feet elevated boardwalk.

End your experience with a delicious meal at *Crabby Crab Restaurant*. Start your meal off with a bowl of Gumbo for your appetizer, followed by Crabby Crab Hair Pasta, Snow Crab Legs, or the Barbecue Shrimp platter.
